INTERNATIONALISATION

The SINO-MALTA Fund supports joint R&I projects (TRL 1-7) between Maltese and Chinese entities across private, public, and academic sectors. Each consortium must include at least one partner from each country, with participants following their respective national application rules through Xjenza Malta or China's Ministry of Science and Technology (MOST).

2025 Call Expected in Q2 2025

Malta-based entities in the consortium are eligible for up to **€200,000 in total funding per project**, provided by Xjenza Malta, with matching funds from MOST for China-based partners. The call budget for Maltese researchers is **€1.2M**, with up to **6 projects** awarded per call.
