- **Decrease formalities and workload in NCBR** by unifying application process for international bilateral calls.

Flexibility in selecting foreign partners without requiring cooperation agreements between R&D funding agencies.

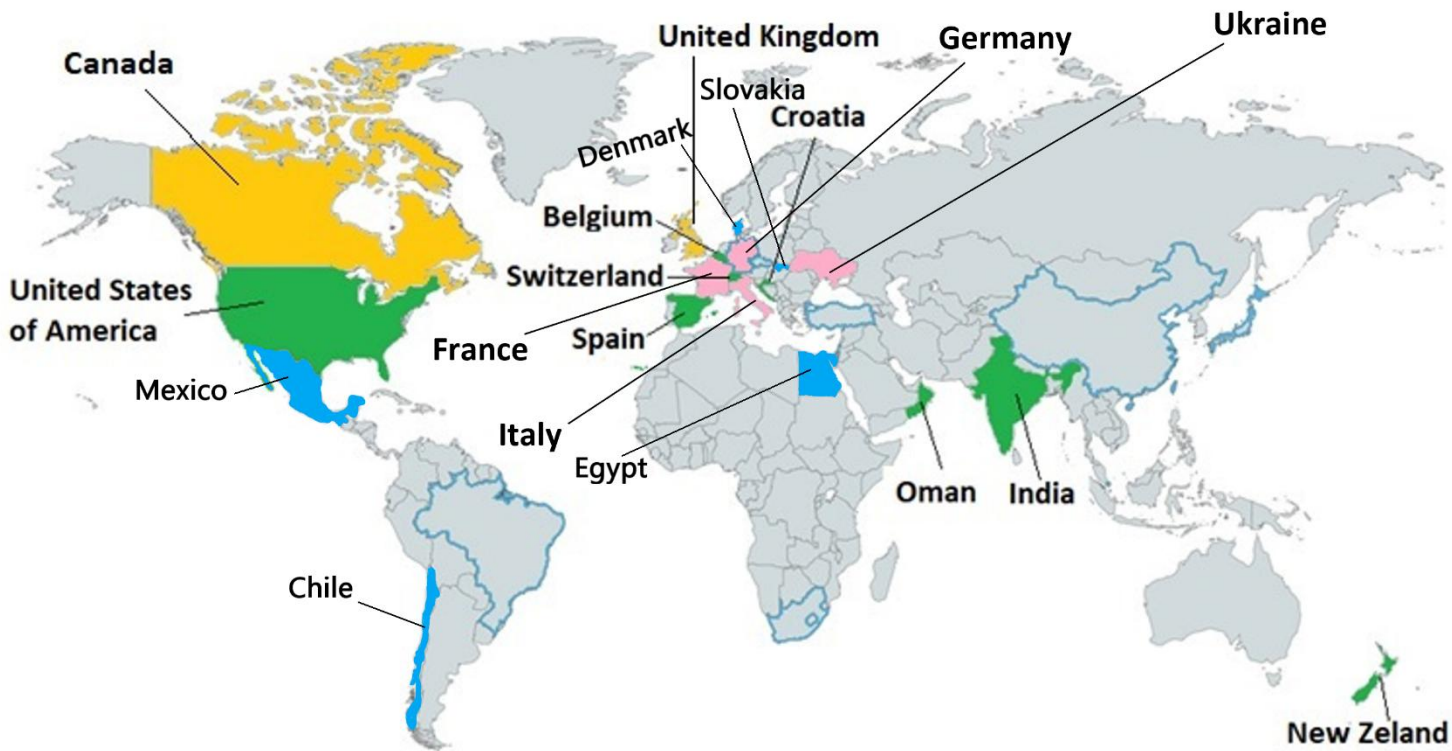

Timetable for the 5th Call:

- Launch of the call: **1 December 2025**
- Deadline for proposals submission: **30 April 2026**
- Formal evaluation: **May-June**
- Substantive evaluation: **June-August**
- Publication of results: **September/October**
- Start of the projects: **October-December**

INNOGLOBO requirements

- The call is open exclusively to international consortia comprising Polish entities and at least one foreign Partner.
- The application to NCBR can be submitted only by a Polish applicant on behalf of the entire international consortium.
- The application to NCBR can be submitted only via the electronic system.
- Single-stage submission of applications.
- Project duration should range from 24 to 36 months.
- **NCBR** may **provide funding** for project implementation **only to Polish entities**.
- **Each Foreign Partner** as a part of an international consortium **is required to secure funding for** the implementation of their respective portions of the **project!**

INNOGLOBO requirements

- The share of financial resources from all the foreign partners forming the international consortium which implements an international project submitted to the 5th INNOGLOBO call should be a minimum of 30% and a maximum of 70% of the total international consortium budget allocated to the project.
- The share of the Polish applicant's financial resources (in case of a national consortium, the total share of all the Polish consortium members) in the international project submitted to the 5th INNOGLOBO call should be a minimum of 30% and a maximum of 70% of the international consortium's total budget allocated for the implementation of the project.
- The international consortium agreement for the project implementation between all the Partners in international consortium is mandatory.
- The international consortium agreement should be:
 - ❖ submitted to NCBR before the conclusion of the project grant agreement;
 - ❖ concluded in writing or electronically (with qualified electronic signatures by all parties to the agreement).

INNOGLOBO requirements - Foreign Partner(s)

- International consortia comprising Polish entities and **at least one foreign Partner**.
- Foreign Partners may originate from **all the countries with which Poland maintains diplomatic ties**.
- **No limitations as to the legal status** of the Foreign Partner(s) which form the international consortium implementing the project.
- Every Foreign Partner in the international consortium implementing the project is obliged to declare and submit a declaration that they have **secured funding for project implementation**. The source of Partner's funding indicated in the declaration can be:
 - ❖ *Foreign Partner's own funds or*
 - ❖ *external funds, such as e.g.: bank credit / loan approval or funding declaration from an R&D financing agency, or an equivalent entity from the foreign country, etc.*

Thematic scope

Thematic scope of the project must be in line with the current Polish List of National Smart Specialisations.

INNOGLOBO Polish requirements - the 5th Call

The Polish applicants:



- ✓ research organisations
- ✓ enterprises
- ✓ consortia

NCBR provides funding for:



- ✓ industrial research
- ✓ experimental development work

Call budget and funding limits:

- **20 mln PLN (~4,7 mln EUR)**
- **300,000 PLN (~70,600 EUR)** - minimum amount of funding for the project
- **2 mln PLN (~470,600 EUR)** - maximum amount of funding for the project

INNOGLOBO - Polish evaluation and selection of projects

Application evaluation by NCBR includes the following stages:

- 1) formal evaluation – to check application eligibility;
- 2) expert evaluation – the scientific and technical evaluation of the project by external experts, 3 reviews per one application;
- 3) compile a ranking list with applications recommended to receive funding.

Based on the ranking list, NCBR's Director issues a decision under which NCBR awards funding for project implementation.



INNOGLOBO - Polish steps to take

Establishing the idea of the project and the scope of planned works between the partners of the consortium.

Submission of international project proposal by the Polish Applicant.

Formal (preliminary) and expert **evaluation** of the submitted project proposal.

Publication of a **ranking list** with applications recommended to receive NCBR funding.
Issued decisions

Submitting international consortium agreement.
Signing the funding agreement with NCBR.
Start of the project.

PartFinder

Online application to search for partners in international R&D projects

- Launched in 2022;
- PartFinder became official tool in many international calls for proposals f.ex.: THCS, Transcan 3, ERA4Health and INNOGLOBO.
