



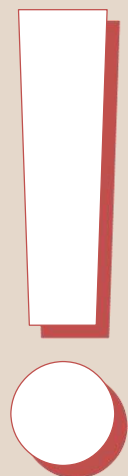

CALL TEXT

Bilateral Cooperation

In 2024, an MoU on cooperation in R&I was signed between Malta and Poland. In line with this MoU, Xjenza Malta and the National Centre for Research and Development (NCBR) are launching this Call. The joint Call for R&I projects is co-funded by Xjenza Malta through the A2GR scheme and by NCBR through the INNOGLOBO programme, with the aim of fostering cooperation and supporting joint initiatives that reflect the shared national priorities of both countries.

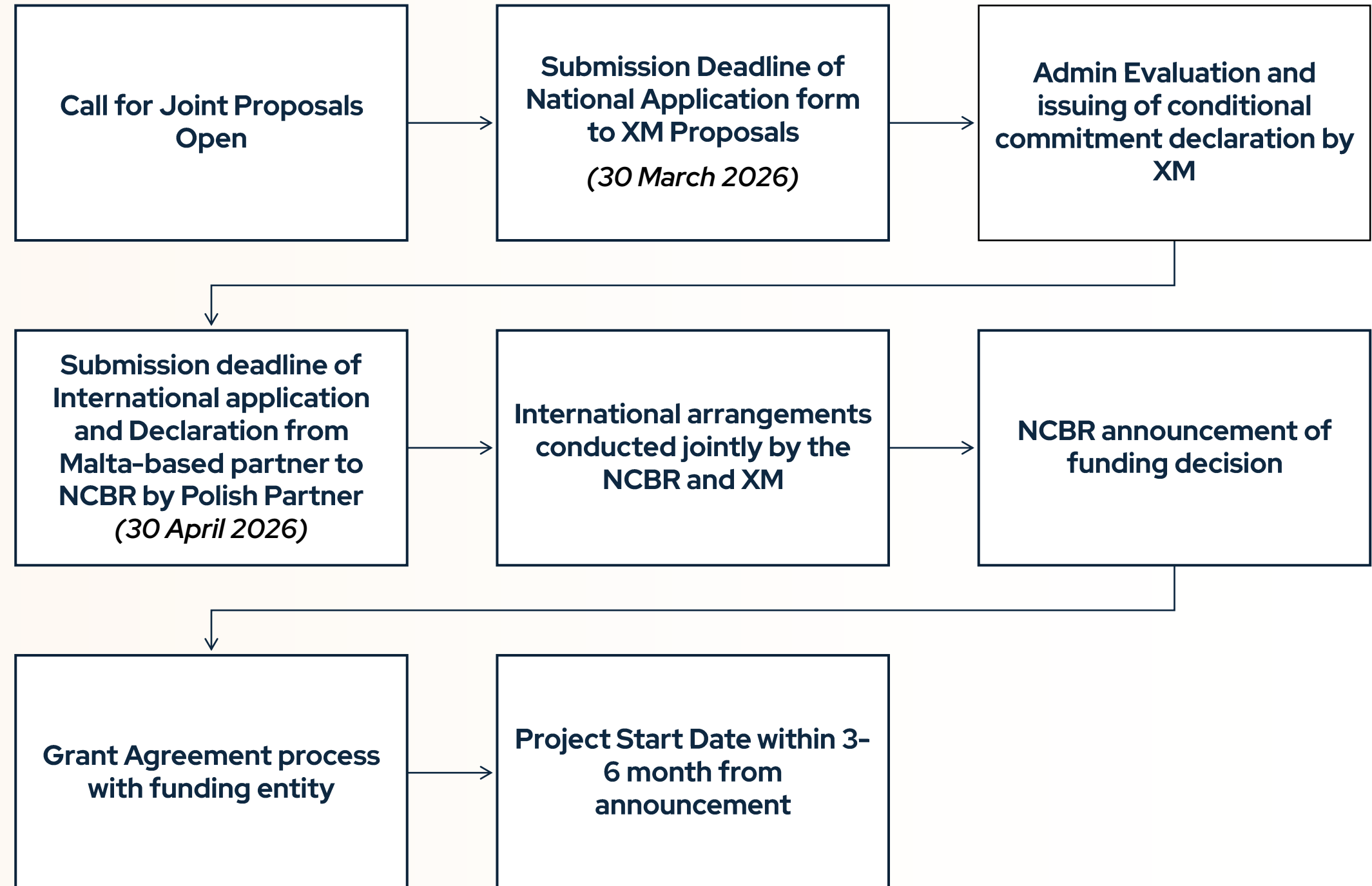

Proposals must follow the procedures established by NCBR and Xjenza Malta, as detailed in the Rules for the participation of Polish applicants in the 5th Call of the INNOGLOBO Programme (Poland), the Xjenza Malta A2GR National Rules, and the Call text (Malta).

FINANCING AND EVALUATION

Eligible participants from Poland and Malta must finance their project costs through their respective national funding schemes - NCBR's INNOGLOBO programme for Poland-based participants and Xjenza Malta's A2GR scheme for Malta-based participants or, where applicable, through complementary self-financing.

- **Evaluation:** Approval or eligibility granted by one funding agency does not imply or guarantee approval by the other. Each funding body conducts its own independent administrative evaluation process and may conduct its own scientific evaluation.
- **Dual Confirmation Required:** A project is considered eligible for funding only after formal confirmation is obtained from both funding agencies.

EVALUATION CRITERIA

Proposals will be scientifically evaluated based on:

- **Scientific and technical excellence and originality of the project**
- **Feasibility, quality and effectiveness of the project plan**
- **Project impact, including anticipated economic effects**
- **Cooperation between consortium partners and added value of the project in the context of international cooperation**



Introduction to the A2GR Scheme NATIONAL RULES AND DOCUMENTATION (MALTA)

INTRODUCTION

- Access2GlobalResearch (A2GR) is a new **flexible national funding scheme** administered by Xjenza Malta to support Malta-based researchers and organisations in **participating in international R&I initiatives** through strategic cross-border collaboration.
- The scheme operates through **targeted calls** aligned with national R&I priorities, enabling Malta to position itself effectively within the global research ecosystem while ensuring efficient use of public funds.
- **Each A2GR Call may include specific objectives and requirements**, and applicants must comply with both the relevant Call Text eligibility criteria and the overarching A2GR national rules.

OBJECTIVES

1. Enhance international collaboration
2. Increase Malta's global research integration and visibility
3. Provide a flexible and responsive funding instrument
4. Align international participation with national priorities
5. Promote balanced and mutually beneficial cooperation

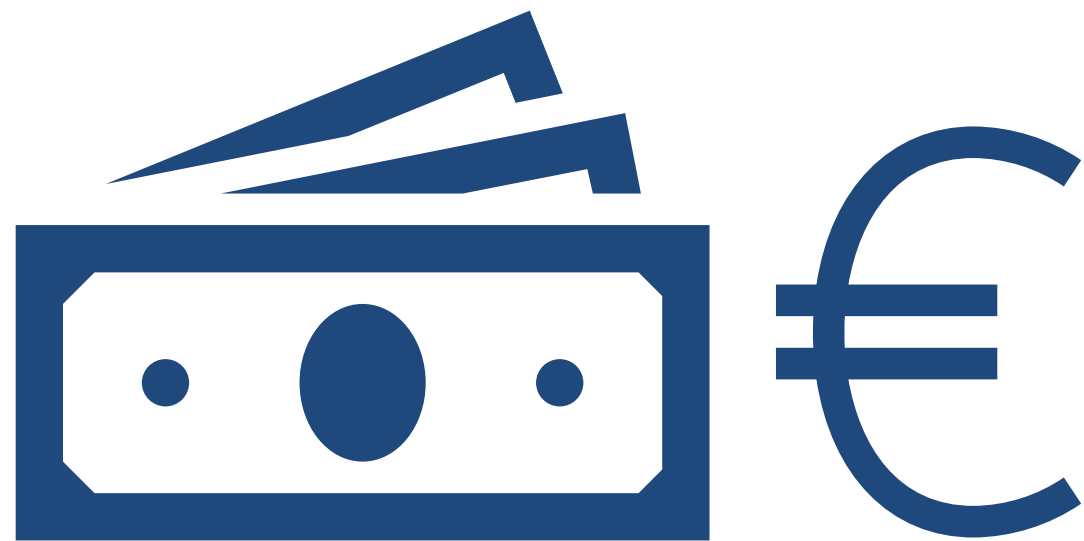

SUBCONTRACTING

- Allowed up to 25% of the project value
- Must follow necessary procurement procedures



IP & KNOWLEDGE TRANSFER ACTIVITIES

Non-economic/*de minimis*/GBER

- Costs of knowledge transfer activities and patents bought or licensed from outside sources at arm's length conditions.



OVERHEADS AND OTHER OPERATING EXPENSES

Non-economic/*de minimis*/GBER

- **Indirect costs that are incurred directly as a result of the project.**
- **These will be covered at 20% of total direct eligible costs claimed.**
- **Should not be listed as separate line items in the budget.**

To be discussed with the Call Manager at the application stage if needed

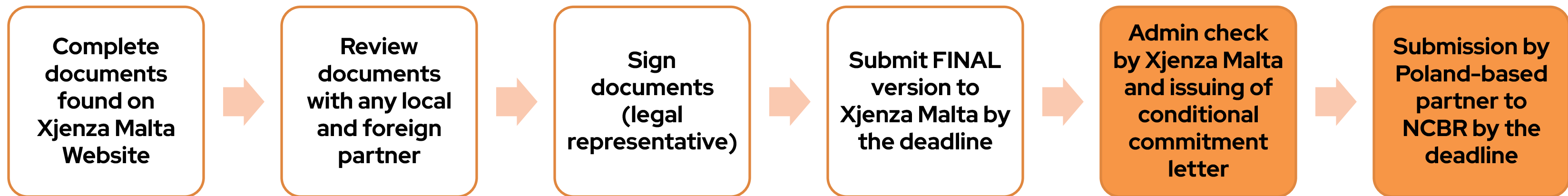

EVALUATION PROCESS


- **Initial Check:** All applications undergo an **administrative eligibility check** by the Managing Authority.
- **Scientific Review:** Eligible projects are evaluated by one or more of the funding agencies, through **external/independent evaluators**, based on criteria specific to the Call Text.
 - **Evaluation methods** and criteria **may change** depending on the specific objectives of different Calls.
- The Managing Authority may conduct **due diligence** through its contractors and request additional assurances or documentation at its discretion.

Minor Deviation = Corrected by Xjenza Malta; applicant can accept or decline the amendment

Major Deviation = Identified by Xjenza Malta; applicant may be invited to fix it, or the application is immediately rejected.
